Who

We would like to expand the resource of the group and are looking for new members who must be current employees of member companies.

Members of the Group shall be appointed for a period of one year, at the end of which they may apply to extend their term if they wish to.

Meetings

Shall be held a minimum of four times per year, either in person or remotely, to be agreed by the NextGen Board.

Purpose

The responsibilities of the NextGen Board shall be:

Promote the air charter industry to youth organisation and educational institutions
- **Events**
Plan, coordinate and execute events for young professionals in the Air Charter industry
- **Marketing**
Promote the NextGen Group's mission to the air charter industry community and encourage others to get involved
- **Professional Development**
Share industry best practices, education, opportunities and knowledge with young professionals
- **Mentorship**
Develop a mentorship program through the Association
- **Advocacy**
Help the Next Generation to better engage, mobilise and deepen their relationships within the air charter industry and act in an advisory role to the Association's Board
