TIPS TO TRAVELING MORE SUSTAINABLY

Join us in our Travel with Purpose efforts and consider the following to help improve your environmental footprint as a transient traveler:

- Bring Your Reusables: Many hotels, airports and destinations offer water stations to fill up your reusable water bottle.
- Go Mobile: It's easy (and convenient!) to access your boarding pass, check-in to your hotel room and receive a hotel folio directly from your phone. Hilton's Digital Key Program resulted in the avoidance of an estimated 92 tons of plastic going to landfills in 2022.
- Make Smart Food Choices: Experience locally sourced, sustainably grown food. Enjoy meatless, plant-rich or dairy-free meal options.
- Select Alternative Wheels: Consider booking a direct flight or renting an electric vehicle to reduce your carbon footprint from transportation.



WAYS TO PLAN A SUSTAINABLE MEETING

Join us in our efforts to Travel with Purpose! Ask us about our Meet with Purpose Check List to support our collaborative efforts to plan more Sustainable Meetings and consider following these examples during your meeting or event:

- Eliminate the use of single-use plastics at your event by switching to reusable options, such as water refill stations, glass/china, travel mugs/bottles, etc.
- Work with the hotel team to reduce food waste through selecting zero-waste menus, plant based menus and creative food presentation, diverting unavoidable food waste from landfill, and/or donating excess, edible food, where allowed by law.
- Encourage attendees to use the Hilton Honors app for digital check-in, keys and check-out to reduce the use of printing, paper and plastic.
- Consider hosting a Carbon Neutral Meeting at Hilton participating hotels.
